2009 City Wide Clean Up

Saturday, May 2nd!

Items may be placed on the curb no earlier than May 1st. Anything on the curb prior to May 1st will be considered a violation of the City's junk ordinance. If an item is deemed "unacceptable" by the city crew, the item will be left at the curbside and is expected to be picked up within 2 hours. Any unacceptable items placed at the curb will NOT be picked up. If unacceptable items are mixed with acceptable items NO items will be picked up. All items remaining at the curb after the clean up crew has passed must be removed within two hours. If these items are not removed a municipal infraction will be issued. The annual clean up day is intended for the use of **Eagle Grove residents only**. Please do not allow nonresidents to use your curb as this will increase the costs of the project. The City will have a drop off area for any Eagle Grove resident who does not want to utilize the curb side pick up. The drop off site will be located at 209 SE First Street and will be open Monday, April 27th through Friday, May 1st from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, and Saturday, May 2nd from 7:00 am until 10:00 am. **No dumping will be allowed when the drop off site is closed.** The same guidelines used for curbside pick up will apply to the drop off site.

NOTE: There is still a charge for using the drop off site (please see "sticker pricing") Please have your drivers license available when entering the drop off site to provide proof of residency.

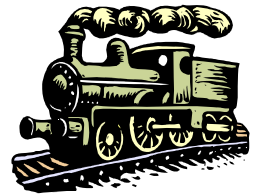
